27 Jul 1856 Ann, d/o William & Frances BULLIVANT, Withern, labourer
6 Feb 1859 William, s/o William & Frances BULLIVANT, Withern, labourer
1 Dec 1859 Charles, s/o Ann WATSON, otherwise ALLETT of Withern, single woman
24 Nov 1861 John William, s/o Mary/Ann [bracketed together in records, one above the other, making it look like she used both names equally] ALLETT & Christopher WHATHAM of Withern, labourer
14 Dec 1861 Ann, d/o William CARROTT & Ann of Withern, labourer
2 Mar 1862 George ALLETT, s/o Esther Ann ALLETT & John WATSON of Withern, labourer
22 Mar 1863 Elizabeth, d/o Christopher & Mary WHATTAM of Withern, labourer
3 May 1863 Ellen d/o William & Ann CARROTT of Withern, carrier
20 Nov 1864 Alice, d/o William & Ann CARROTT of Withern, carrier
12 Feb 1865 Thomas, s/o Christopher & Mary WHATTAM of Withern, labourer
7 Oct 1867 Catherine, d/o William & Ann CARROTT of Withern, carrier
17 Feb 1867 Joseph, s/o Christopher & Mary WHATTAM of Withern, labourer
24 Feb 1867 Amos, s/o William & Frances BULLIVANT of Withern, labourer
4 Oct 1868 Betty, d/o William & Ann CARROTT of Withern, carrier
6 Dec 1868 Esther Ann, d/o Christopher & Mary WHATTAM of Withern, labourer
23 Oct 1870 Eliza, d/o William & Ann CARROTT of Withern, carrier and farmer

9 Jul 1877 Maddison William, s/o William & Sophy ALLETT of Withern, bricklayer

Burials:

13 Jul 1757 David JOHNSON, a young man highly industrious was slain by a fall from a waggon.

21 Jan 1767 John Thomas CAMPLIN, a miser cottager.
3 Feb 1767 Old Robb GRIFFIN, a helpless man came to no church! a poor dish:
Gurney (sic).
28 Mar 1767 Robt son, infant, of Thos/Jane LANCASTER, cottager and heavy.
2 Apr 1767 Sarah DAWSON, old wife of John, a laborious pauper.
12 Oct 1770 John JOHNSON, an old crabbed cottager.
